The Intelligent Investor - Benjamin Graham

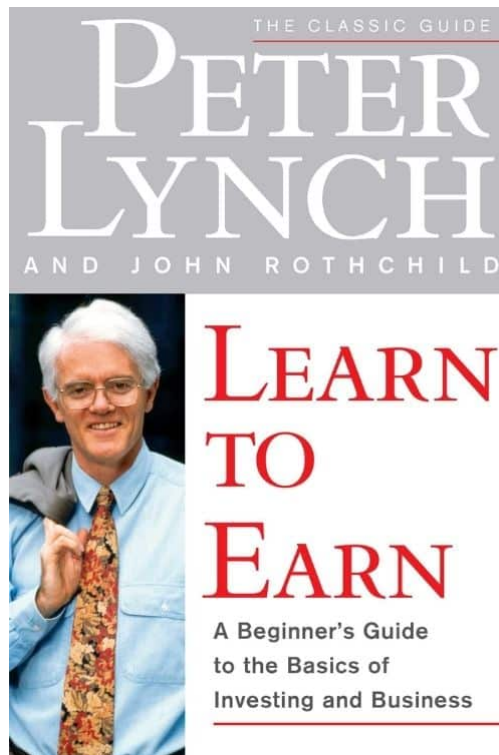

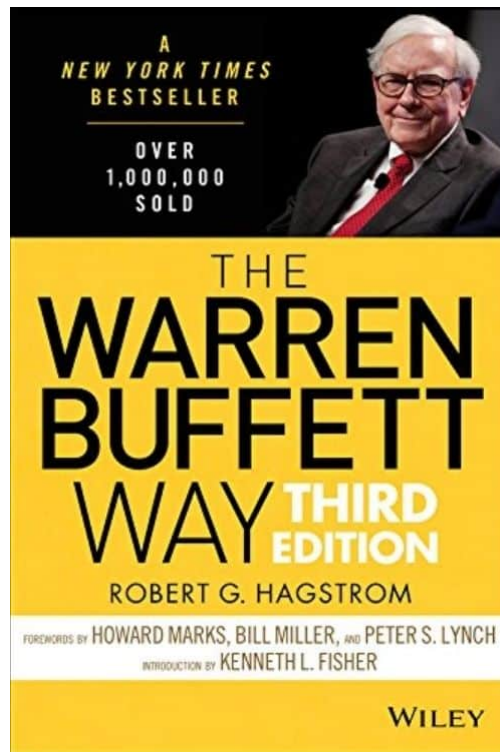

The Warren Buffett Way - Robert G. Hagstrom

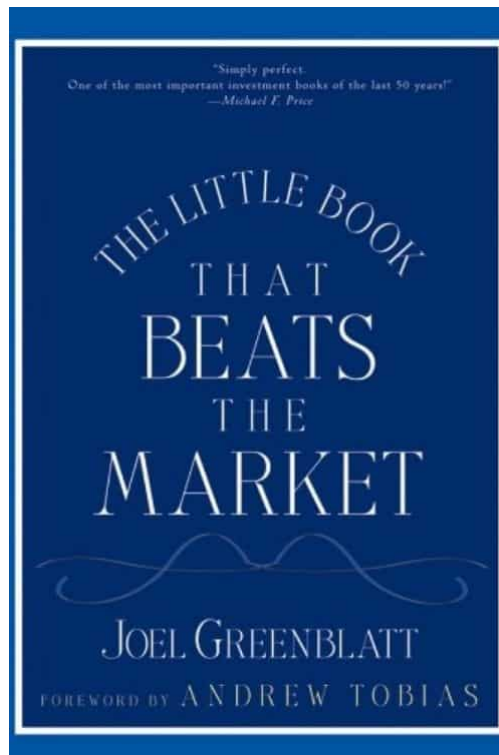

The Little Book that Beats the Market - Joel Greenblatt

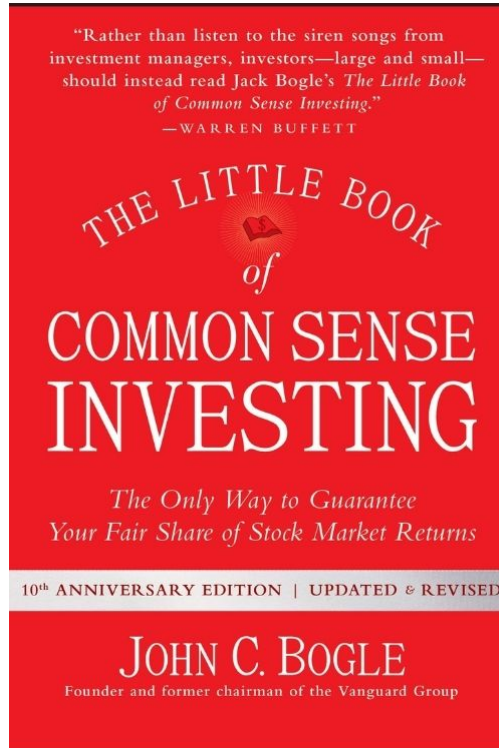
