

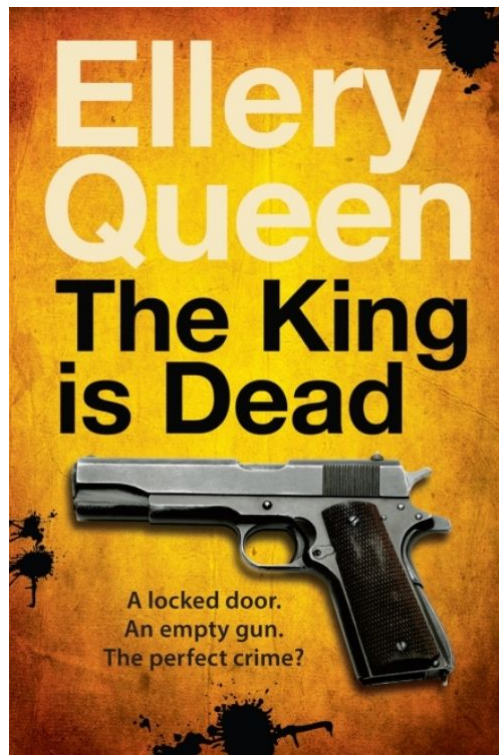

The King is Dead: By Ellery Queen

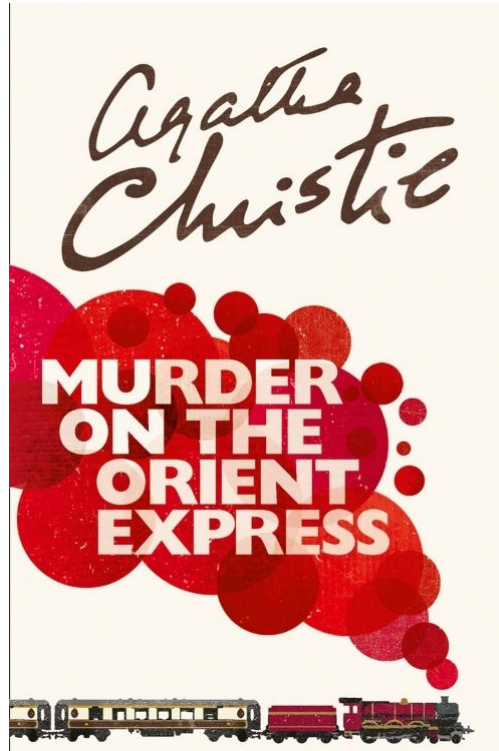

Murder on the Orient Express: By Agatha Christie

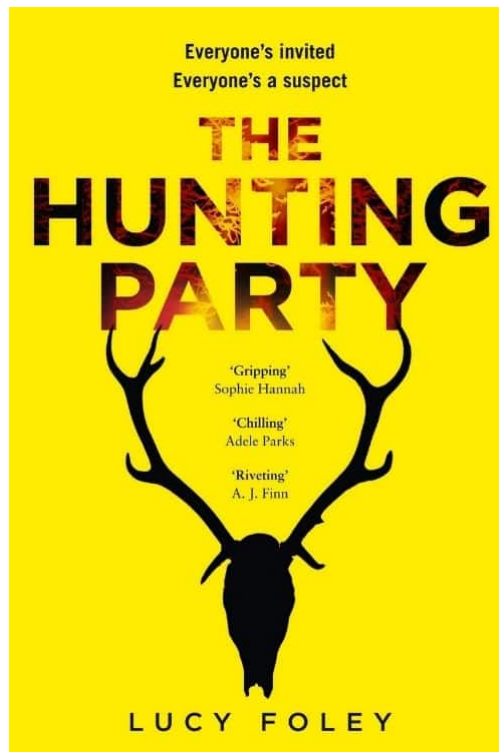

The Hunting Party: By Lucy Foley

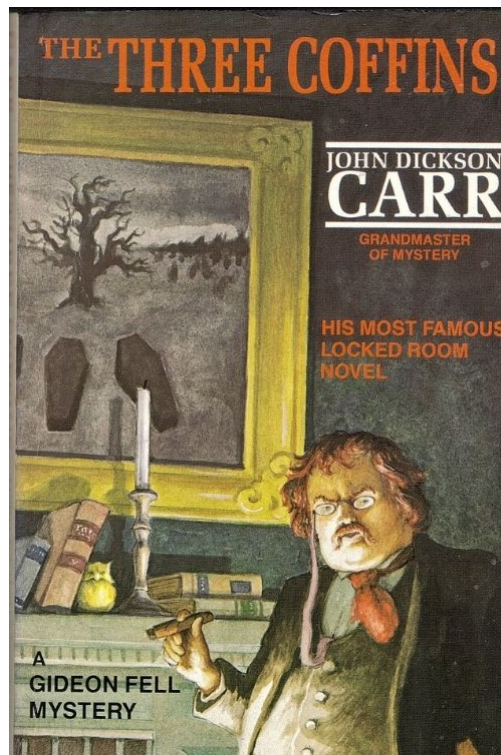

The Three Coffins: By John Dickson Carr

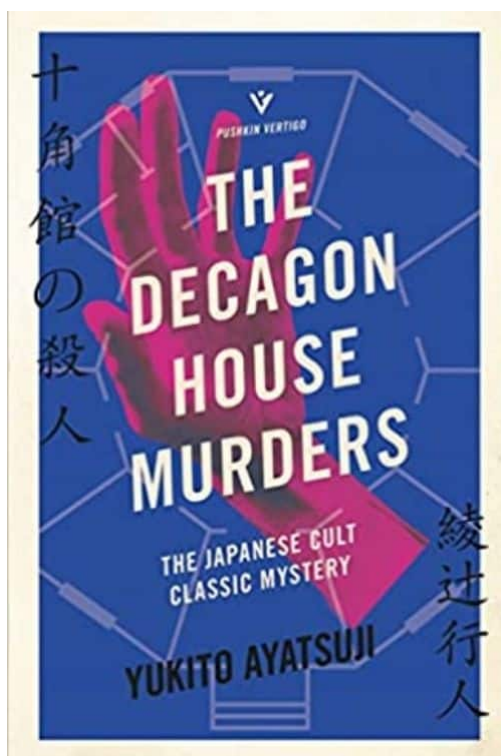

The Decagon House Murders: By Yukito Ayatsuji

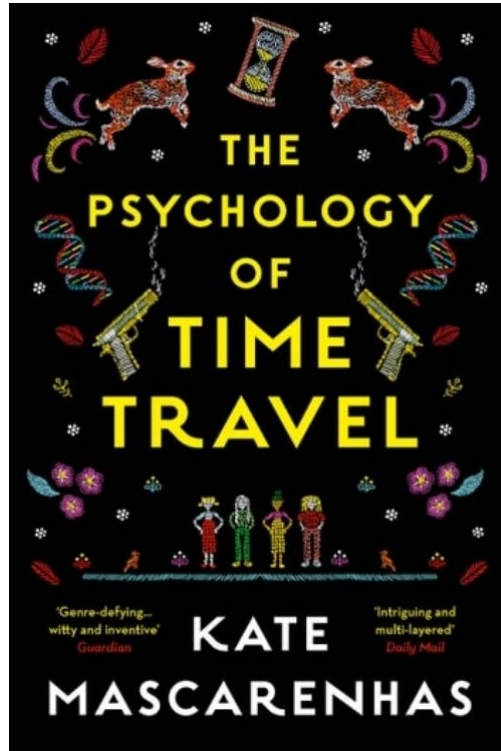

The Psychology of Time Travel: By Kate Mascrenhas

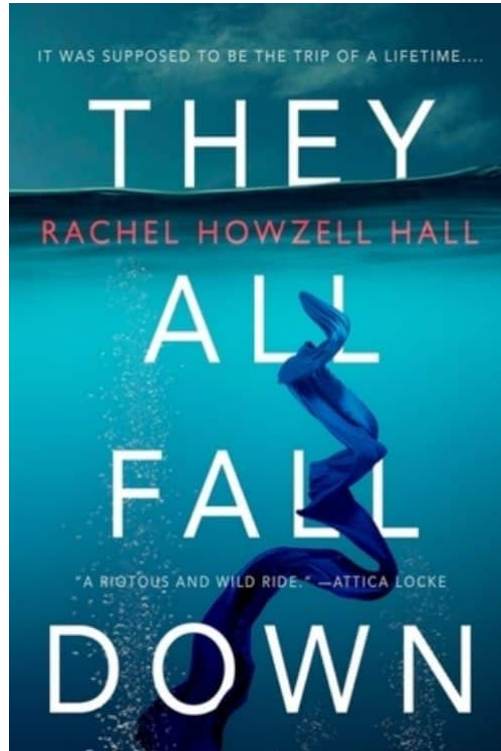

They All Fall Down: By Rachel Howzell Hall

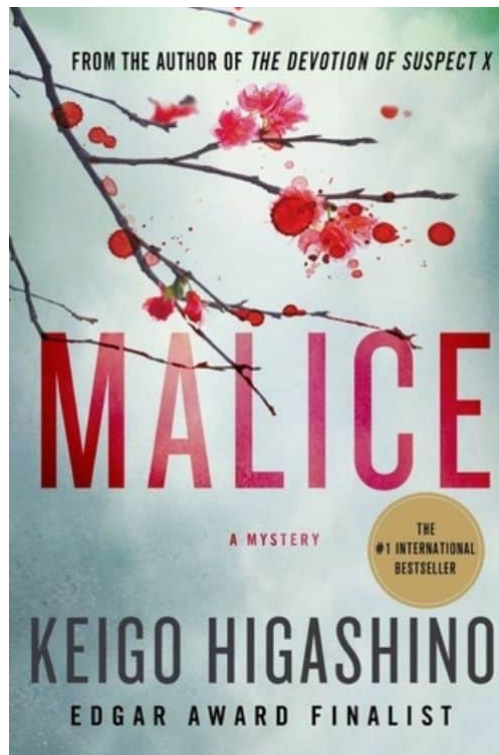

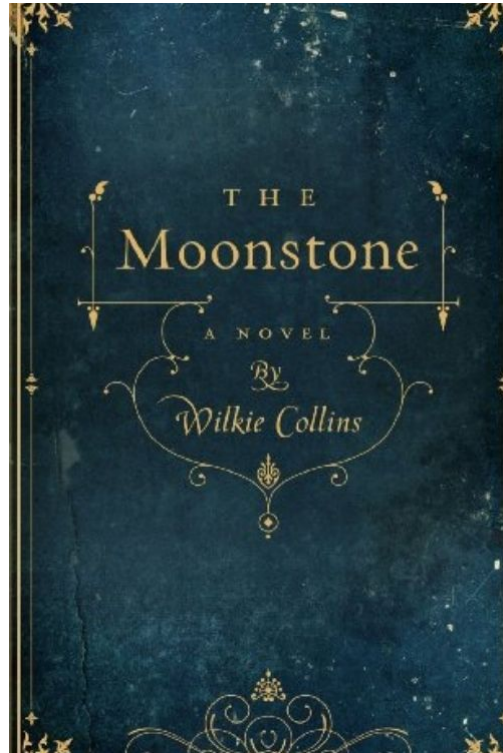
