

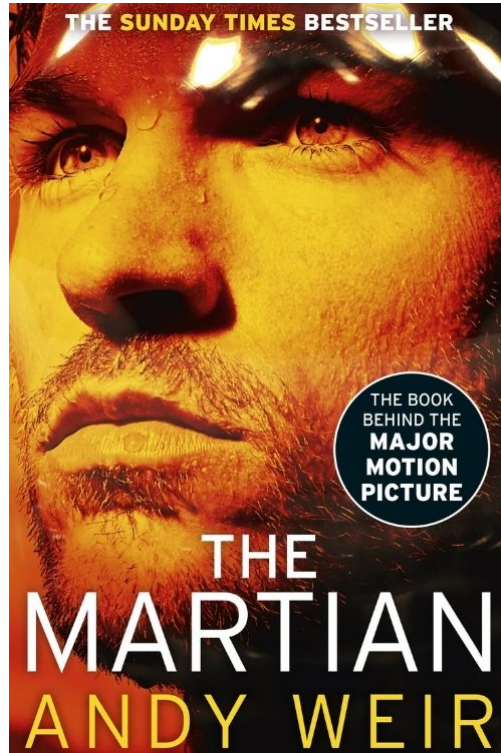

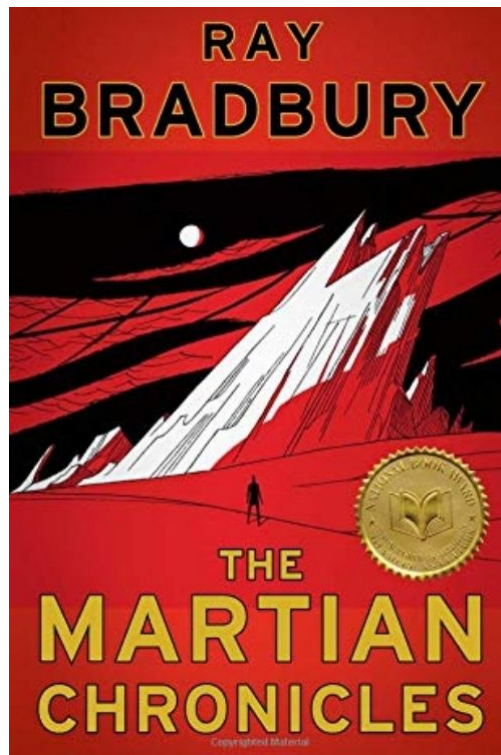

**The Martian Chronicles - Ray Bradbury**

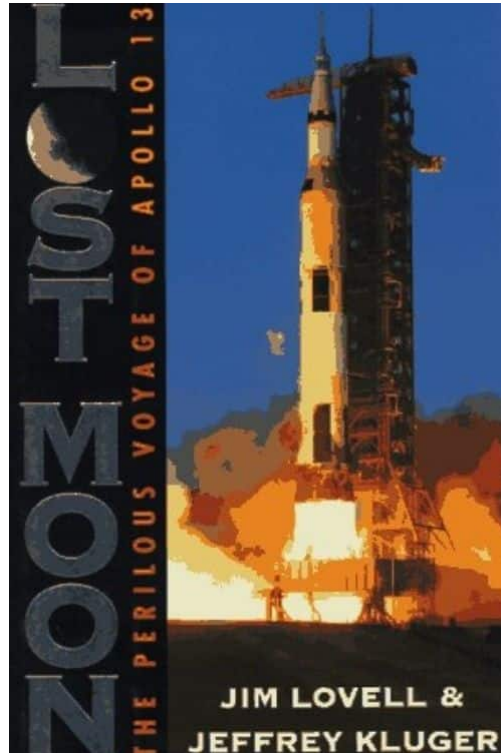

**Lost Moon - Jim Lovell**

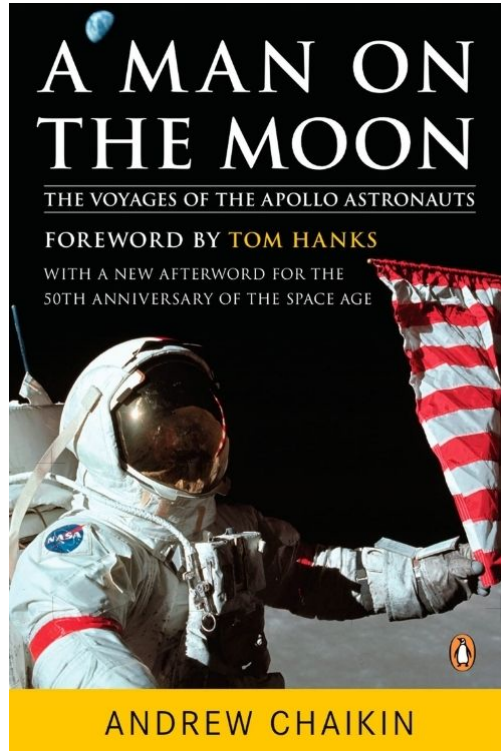

## **A Man on the Moon - Andrew Chaikin**

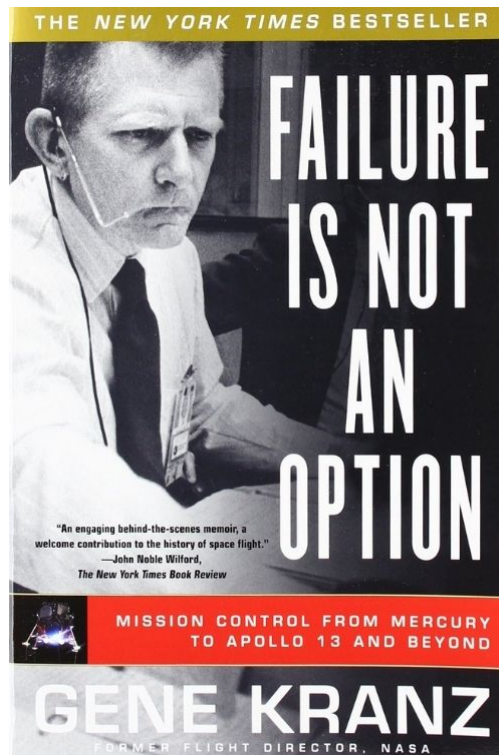

## **Apollo 8 - Jeffrey Kluger**

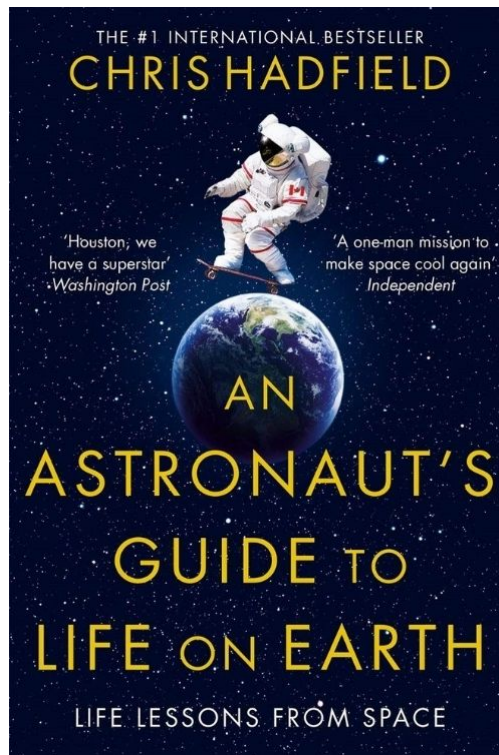

## **An Astronaut's Guide to Life on Earth - Chris Hadfield**



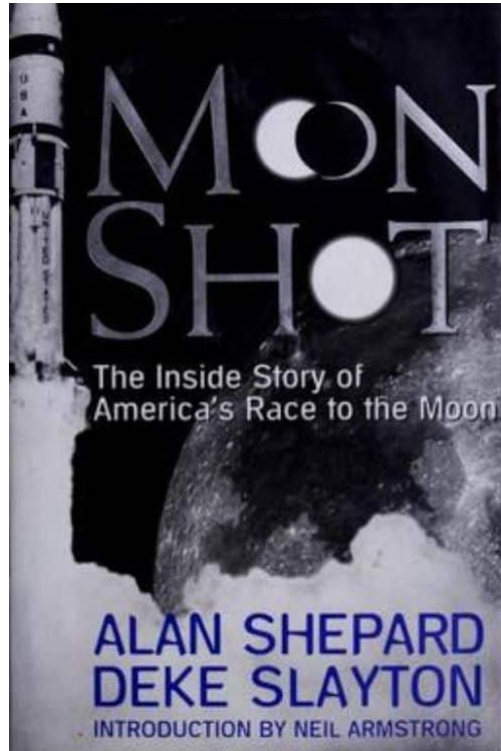

**Moon Shot - Alan Shepard**



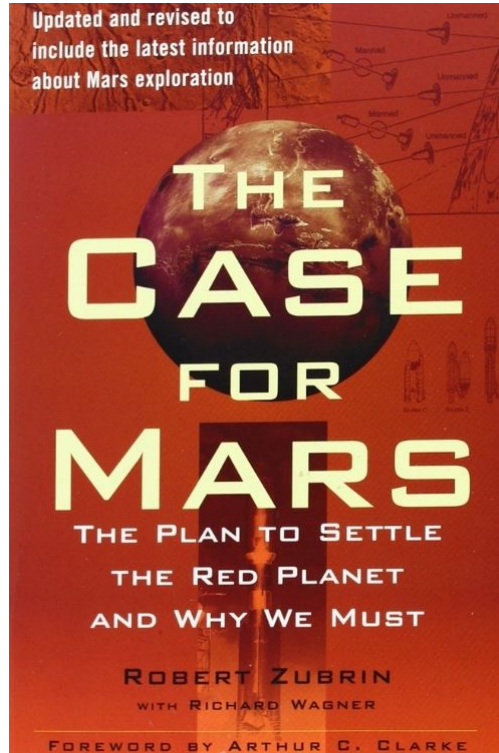

## **The Case for Mars - Robert Zubrin**

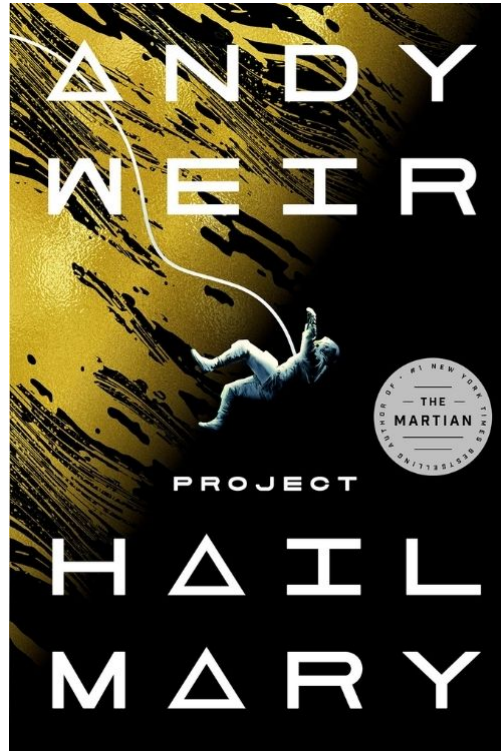
