

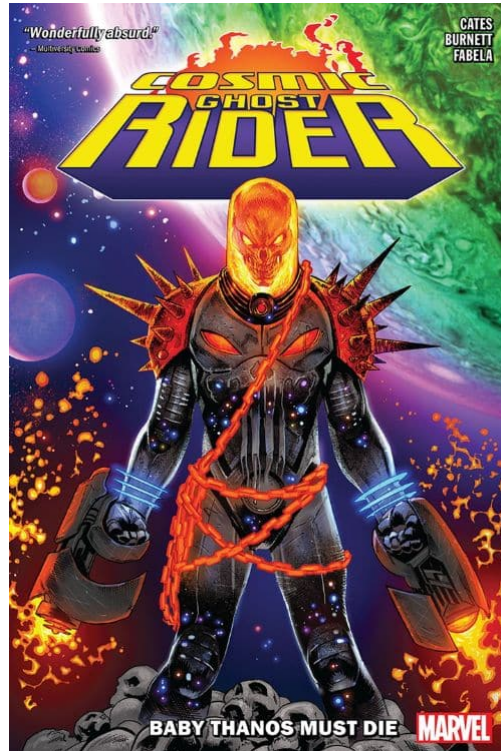

Quicksilver

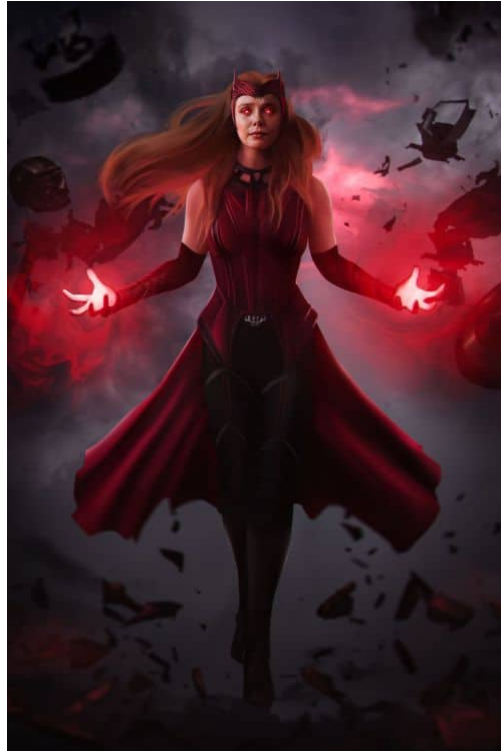
