




Arch-Conspirator






Kyr has been preparing all her life to avenge the murder of planet Earth. She grew up in





The Criminal Action Penal Entertainment (CAPE) program is a controversial entertainment platform within the private prison industry, where prisoners fight in death-matches for the ultimate prize of their freedom. The gladiators travel as Links in Chain-Gangs, competing in front of packed arenas with righteous protestors outside.

Thurwar and Staxxx are both teammates and lovers and the fan favorites. Thurwar is close to winning her freedom, and she intends to help her fellow Links preserve their humanity, despite the inhumanity of their situation. However, CAPE's corporate owners will do anything to protect their profit-driven program, and their efforts have devastating



consequences for the gladiators. "Chain-Gang All-Stars" is a powerful critique of America's systemic racism, unchecked capitalism, and mass incarceration, and a clear-eyed exploration of the meaning of freedom in a country where justice is far from equal.






