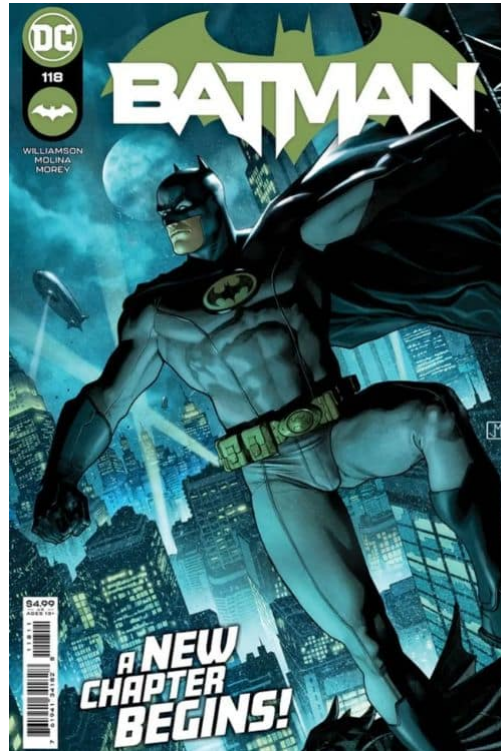
Lex Luthor
