Spongebob






15 Most Loved Cartoon Characters of All Time - Spongebob

Bugs Bunny






Bugs Bunny

Dr. Doofenshmirtz






Dr. Doofenshmirtz

Charlie Brown






15 Most Loved Cartoon Characters of All Time - Charlie Brown
