

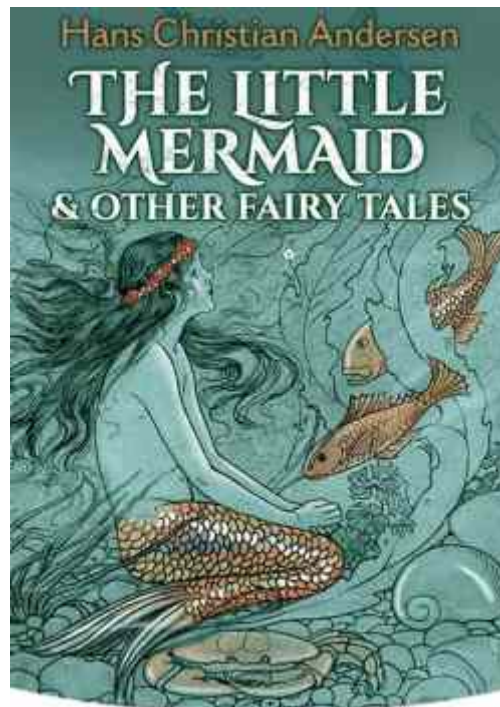

### **The Little Mermaid by Hans Christian Anderson**

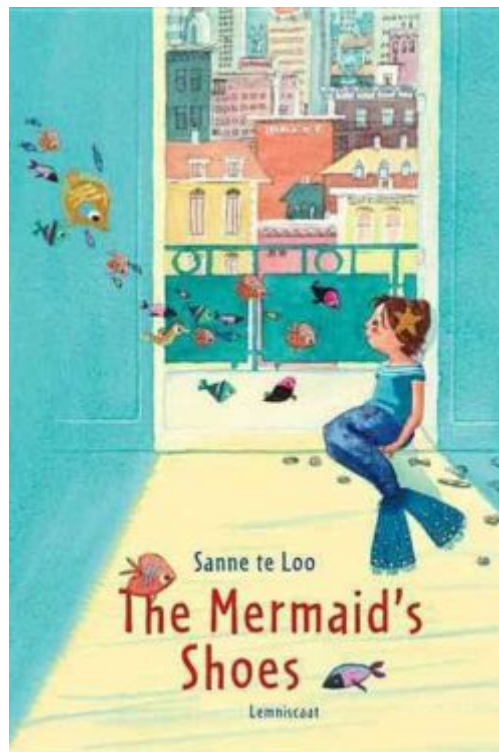

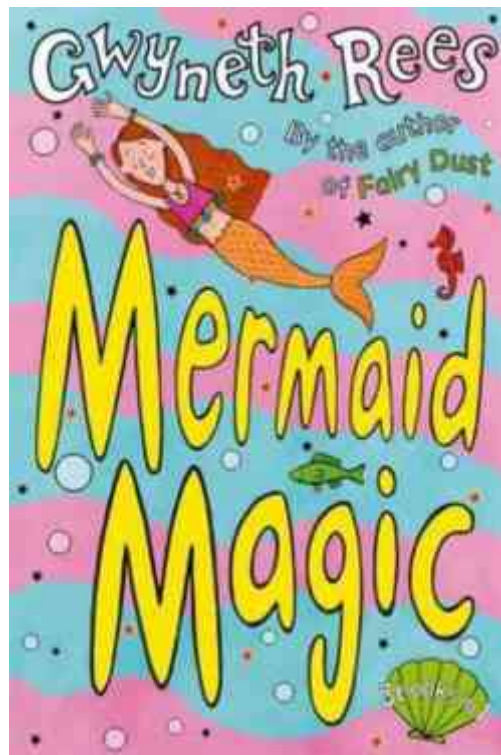
**Maybe a Mermaid by Josephine Cameron**

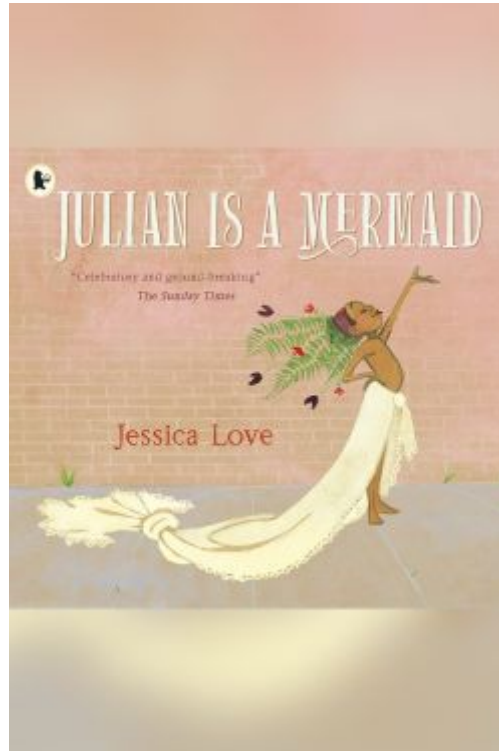
## **Mermaid Magic by Gwyneth Rees**

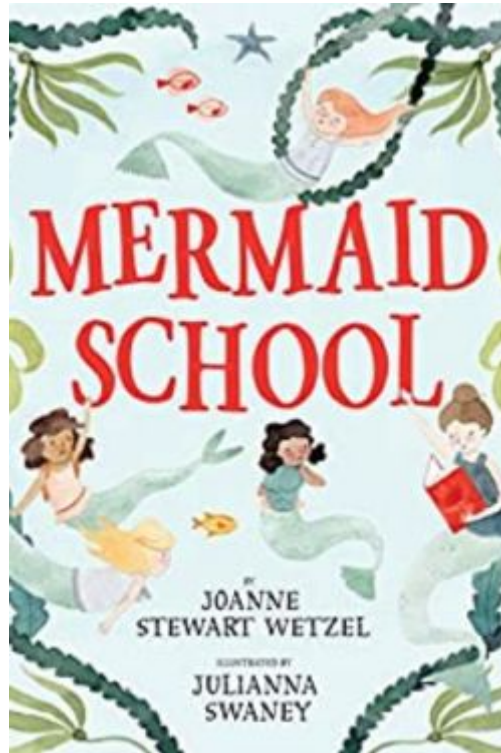
## **Julian is now a Mermaid by Jessica Love**

## **Mermaid School by Joanne Stewart Wetzel**

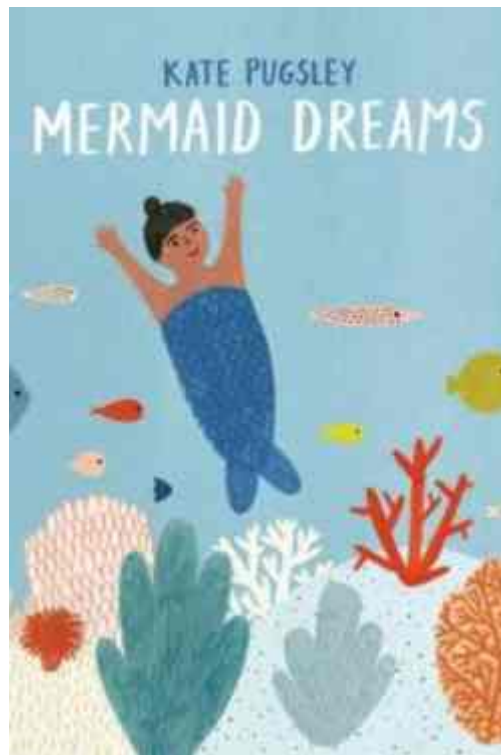


*Enchanting Books About Mermaids For Kids (Mermaid School by Joanne Stewart Wetzel)*
