John Cabot's Historic Landing - 1497 AD

John Cabot became the first European since the Vikings to land in North America in 1497, claiming parts of Canada for England and opening the door for future exploration.

Theodore Beza's Birth and Impact - 1519 AD




The Battle of Solferino - 1859 AD

The Promoters Revolution in Thailand - 1932 AD

Berlin Blockade Intensifies - 1948 AD

On June 24, 1948, the Soviet Union escalated the Berlin Blockade by cutting off all land routes to West Berlin, prompting the Western Allies to initiate the Berlin Airlift.

Lionel Messi's Birthday - 1987 AD

Lionel Messi, born on June 24, 1987, in Rosario, Argentina, rose to become one of the greatest football players in history, known for his exceptional skill and numerous records.

Julia Gillard's Historic Swearing-In - 2010 AD
