Franz Joseph was crowned king of Hungary in 1867, marking a significant event in the Austro-Hungarian Empire's history.

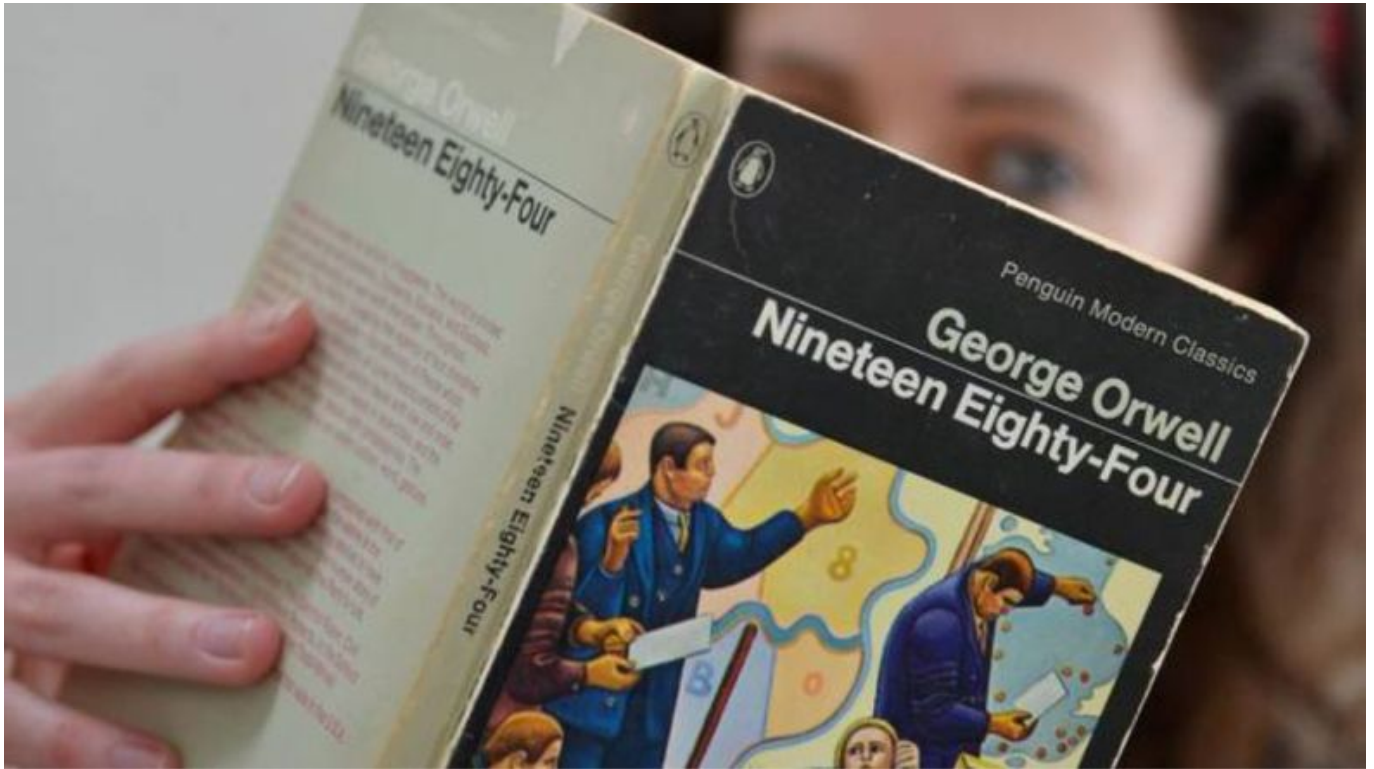
Birth of Francis Crick - 1916 AD

Death of Anthony Bourdain - 2018 AD
