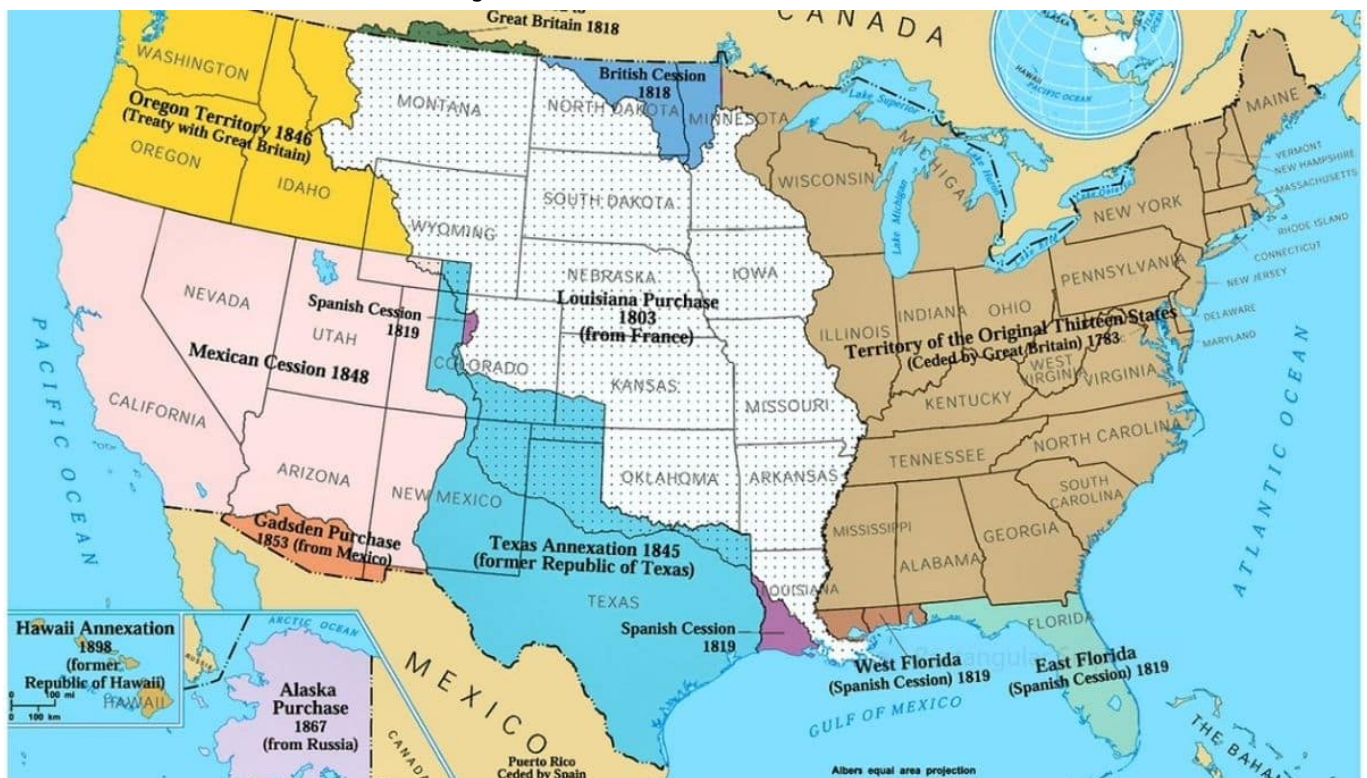
1815 Rimini Proclamation for Italian Unity

1822 Florida Territory Established

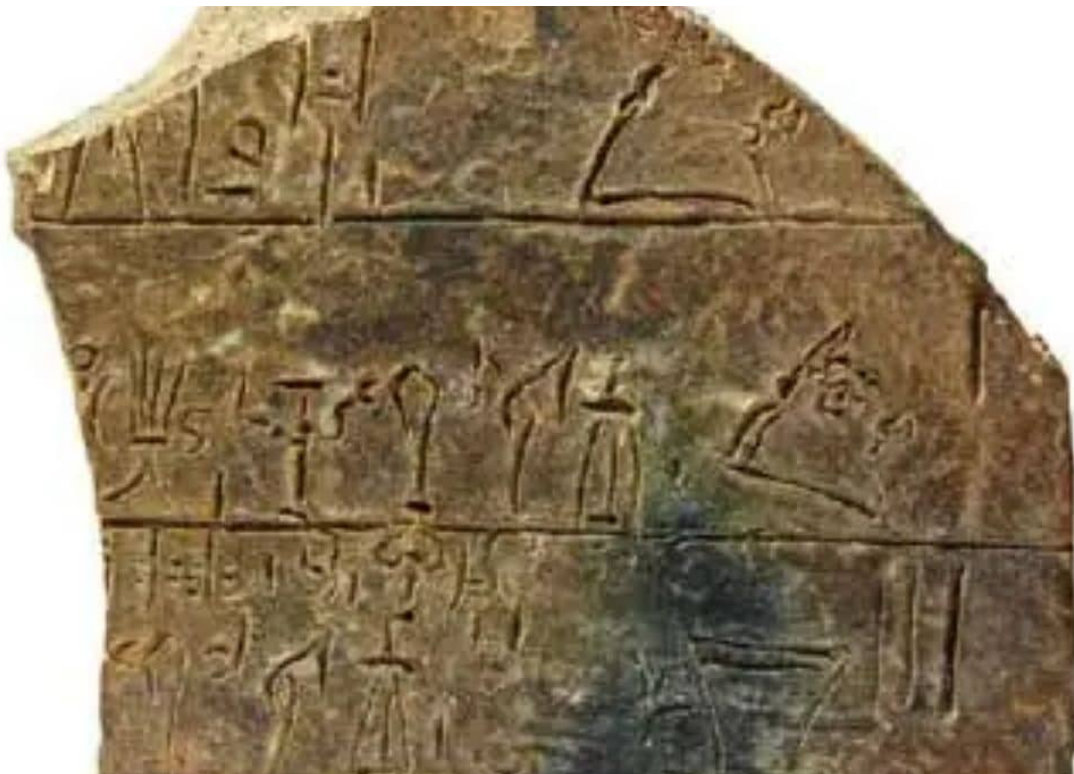
1870 Texas Rejoins U.S. Congress

Soviet and Polish forces free Vienna and Danzig. These liberations marked critical victories in WWII, hastening the conflict's end in Europe.



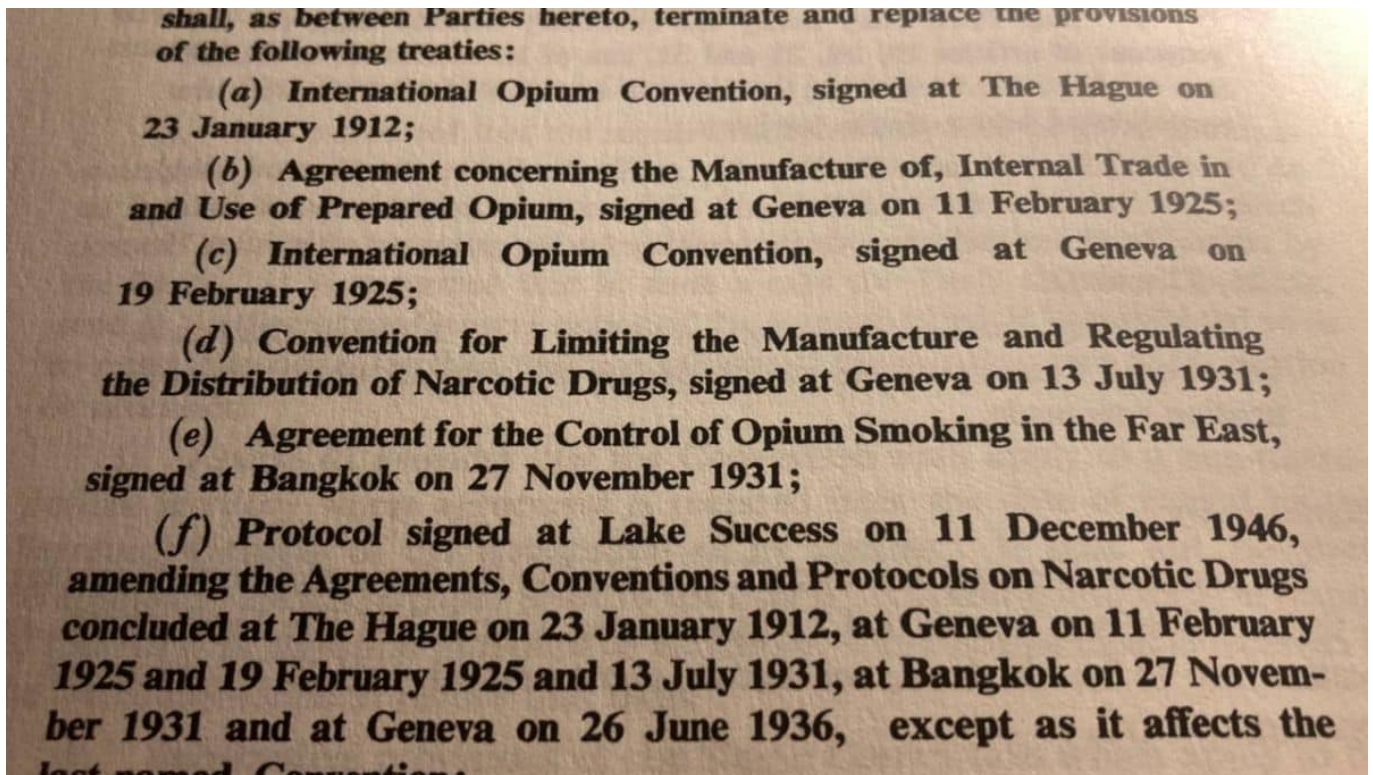
1949 Iceland Riots Over NATO Membership
