

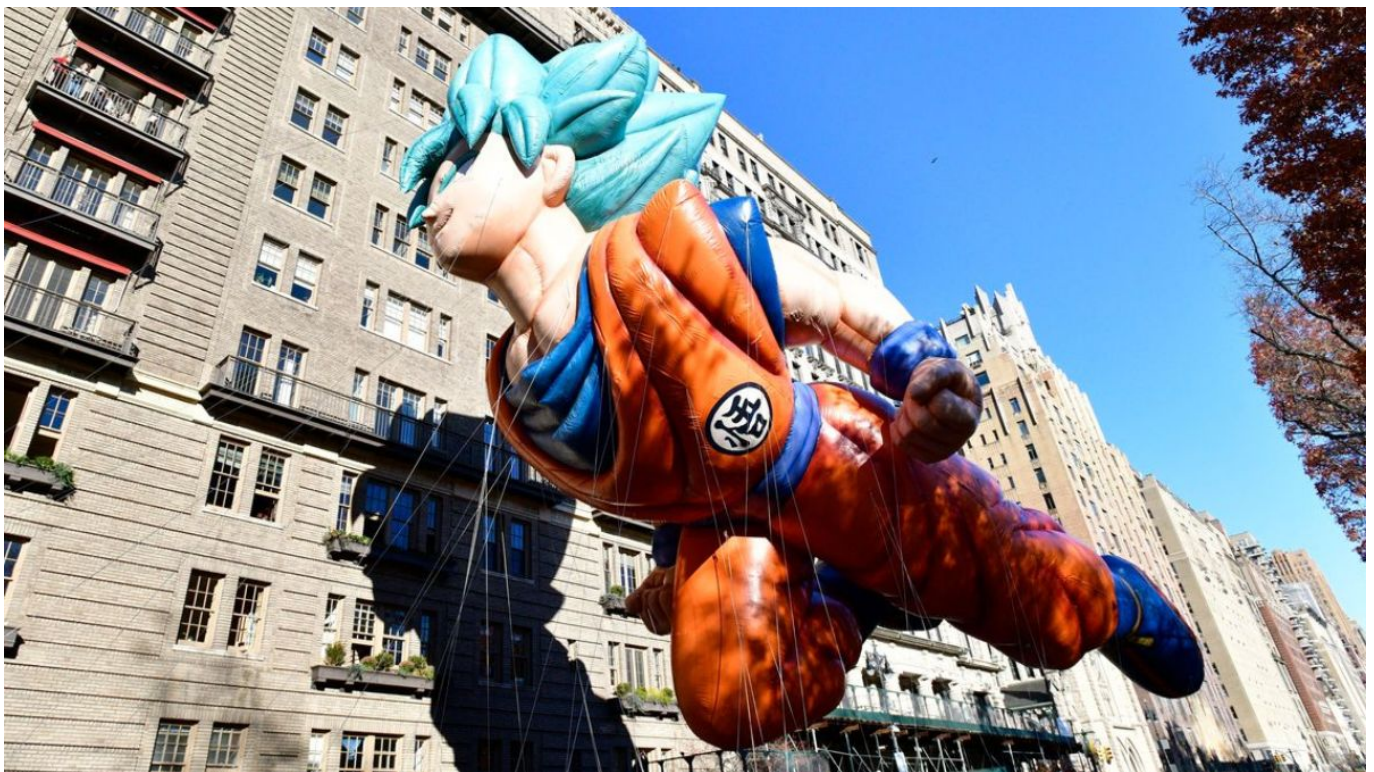


Saudi Arabia to Construct the World's First 'Dragon Ball' Theme Park | 1
