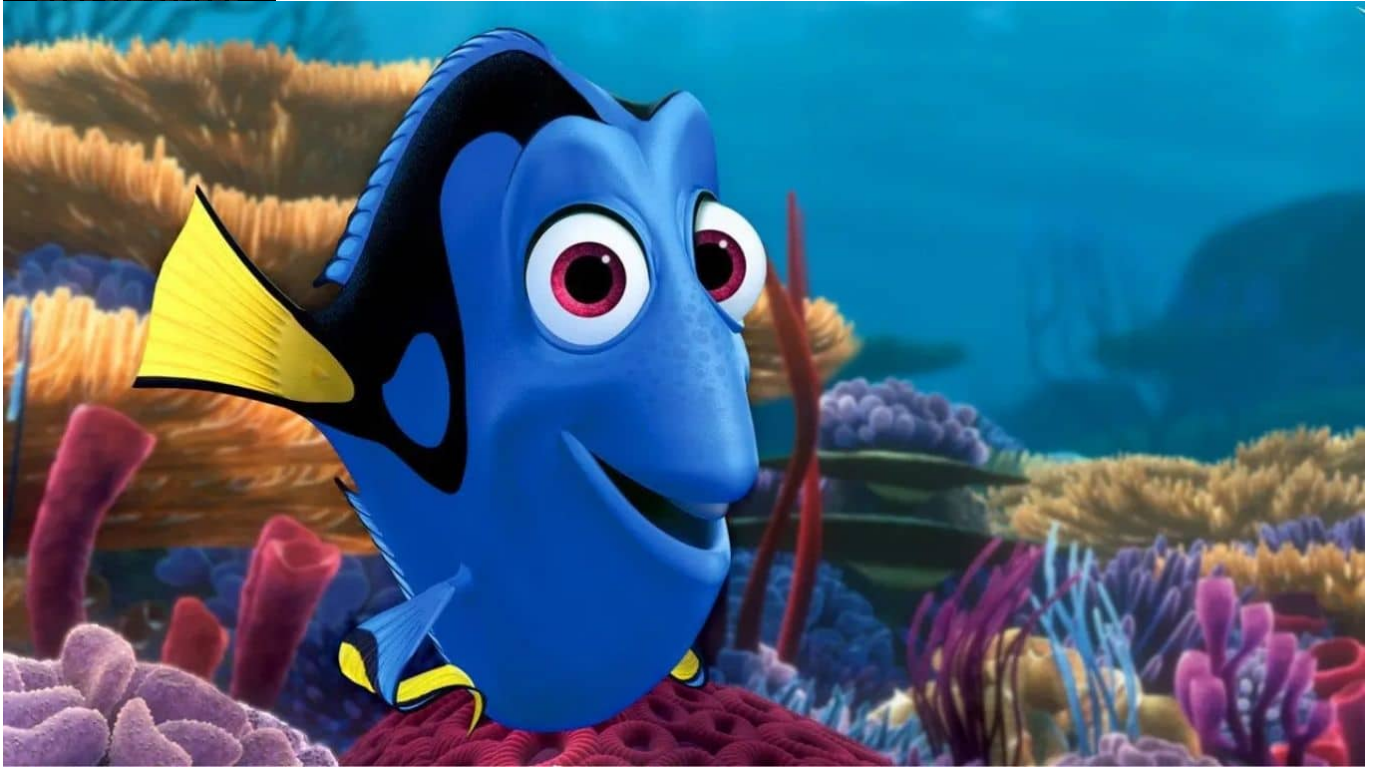

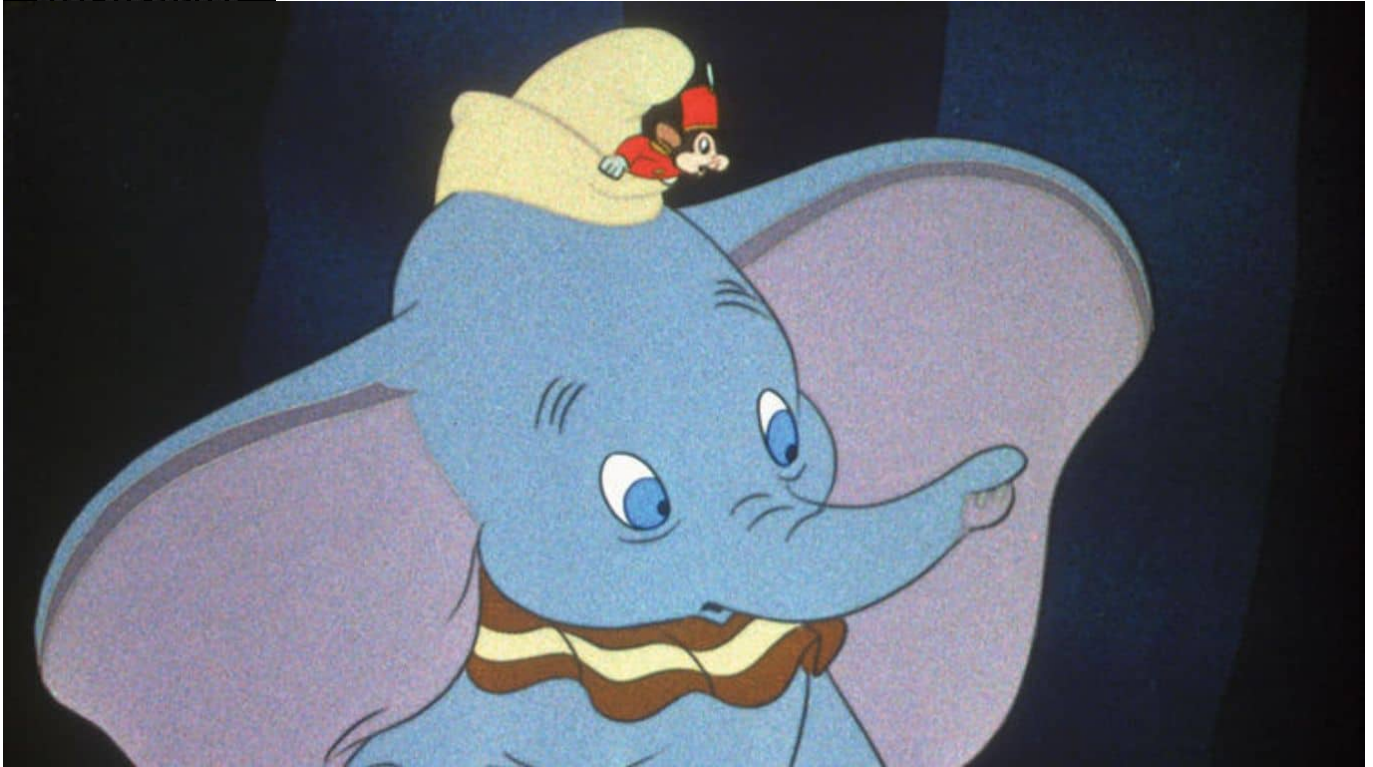
Dory
