The Oracle Code

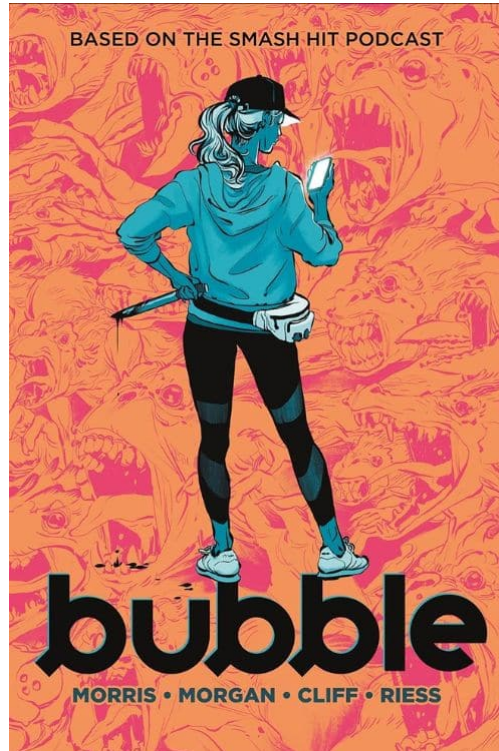

Monstress

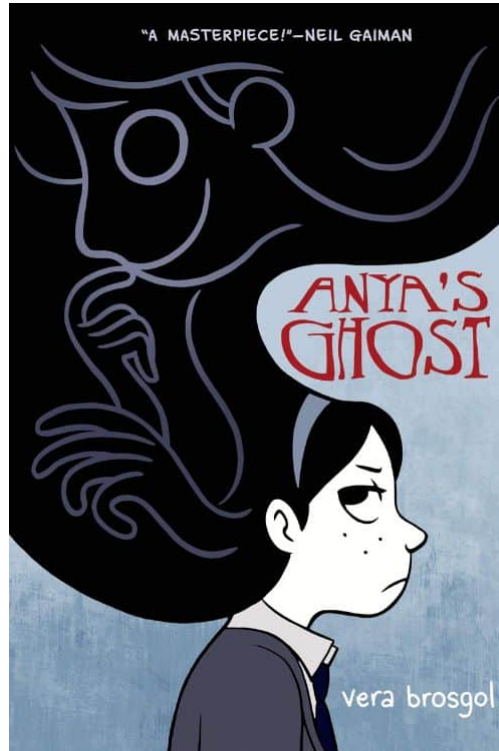

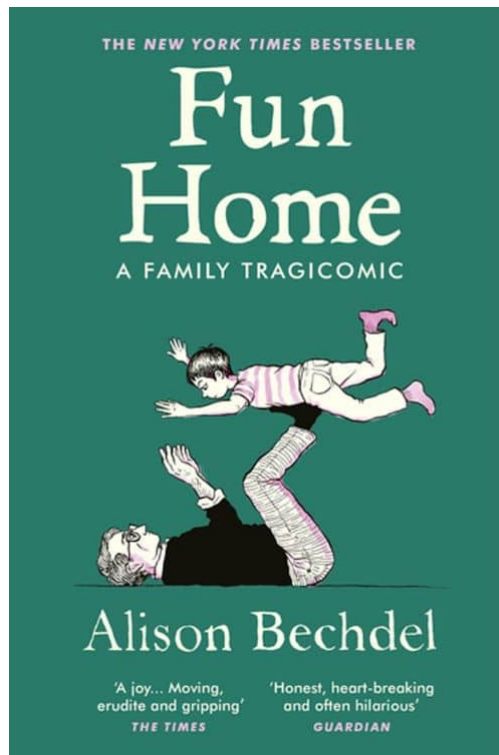

Fables - Legends in Exile

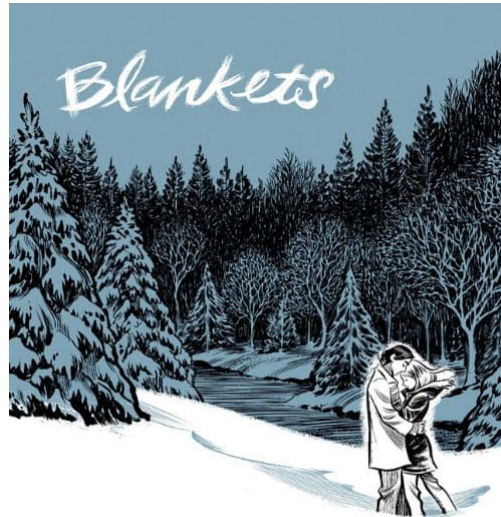

Blankets



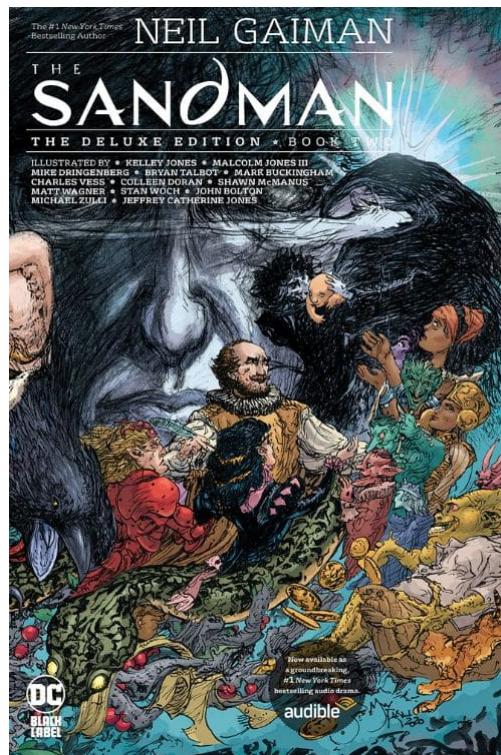

The Sandman

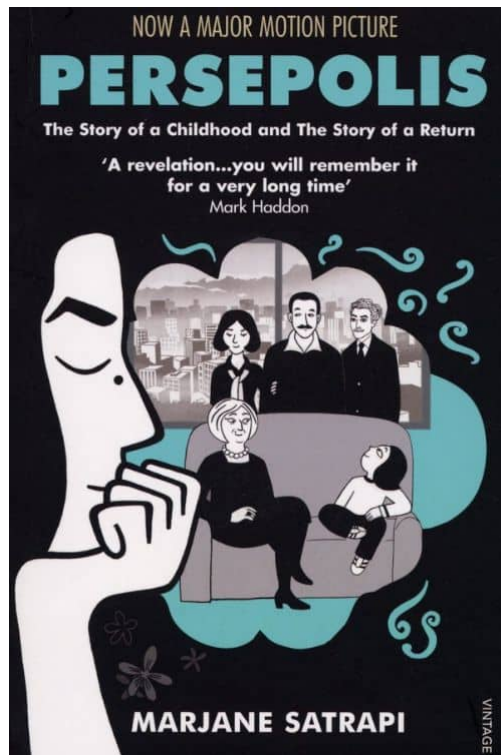
